

2021 GREG NORMAN ESTATES KNIGHTS VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

REGION: Knights Valley, Sonoma, California
VARIETALS: Cabernet Sauvignon
ANALYSIS: 14.5% alc/vol | 5.8 g/L TA | 3.7 pH

REGION: Located within Sonoma County near the Napa Valley border, Knights Valley is protected from direct Pacific Ocean influence, and is the warmest of Sonoma County's viticulture areas, where ideal growing conditions produce remarkable Cabernet Sauvignon and Bordeaux varietals.

WINEMAKING: The fruit was picked in the cool of the morning and transported to the winery where it was destemmed and crushed into small open top tanks. Once fermentation was complete the wine was pressed and transferred into neutral vessels for aging.

TASTING NOTES: Ripened berries, currants and notes of espresso. This is a well-structured wine, defined by grace and balance, with a firm backbone yet is elegant and approachable.
